

### RTDB book selections

- Crying in H Mart by Michelle Zauner is the adult book selection. Zauner's candid coming-of-age story speaks of growing apart from, and then back together with her Korean identity and of forging her own path in the wake of devastating loss. With humor and heart, she tells of growing up Asian American, straining to meet her mother's expectations, moving across the country, and returning home to reckon with grief.
- The teen book is Family Style by Thien Pham. This is a moving young adult graphic memoir about a Vietnamese immigrant boy's search for belonging in America.
- Stand Up, Yumi Chung! by Jessica Kim is a heartfelt story about family and self-discovery for ages nine to twelve. As an aspiring comedian, Yumi fears there isn't enough room on stage for her own experiences and stories to shine —because when all is said and done, comedy is really just another form of storytelling.
- Ramen for Everyone by Patricia Tanumihardja is an adorable picture book for young children. Hiro loves ramen. Every Sunday, Hiro's dad makes delicious, perfect ramen for dinner using a recipe passed down from his dad. Hiro then proceeds to discover that every person's perfect bowl of ramen is unique.




